#### Here's how you can get your Social started:

- 1. You and friends come up with a creative party idea! See bottom for guidance.
- 2. Come up with a theme and plan your details around that idea. It can be as formal or informal as you like, NO STRESS...Just FUN!!!
- Think about the number of people you think would be appropriate for the party. Some parties have as few as 4 guests and some have 40+.
- 4. Plan your location. You can have a party at your home or you may need to reserve a party place
- 5. Pick a date for your party. **You must have a date before submitting for auction**. If it is an outdoor event, plan a rain date.
- 6. Write out your party plan on a Benefit donor form. Be sure to list: all <u>host/hostesses</u>, the <u>theme</u> for the party, the <u>location</u>, the <u>date</u> (and rain date), the <u>beginning and ending times</u> for the party and the <u>cost</u> per person or per couple. Your completed donation form (attached or copies in the front office) is due no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.
- 7. You will be given a guest list as soon as possible after the Benefit.
- 8. Invitations or evite for your party are your responsibility.
- 9. You and your co-hosts are responsible for underwriting the cost of the event. There's no limit to the number of hosts or hostesses.
- 10. Have a GREAT time, meet new friends AND raise money for South Loop Elementary.
