#### South Loop/Youth Guidance General Info

<u>South Loop Elementary</u> is a public neighborhood school centrally located in Dearborn Park. The school offers several programs: the Neighborhood Fine Arts Program, a Regional Gifted Center, Extended Day Program, and a tuition-based Pre-School to students coming from a wide range of ethnic and social-economic backgrounds. Our goal is to provide an excellent public education for children of all levels and abilities. We are creating a learning environment where expectations are high, diversity fosters respect and appreciation, and each child becomes well prepared to succeed as a lifelong learner who will reach his or her full potential.

<u>Youth Guidance</u>, a school-based non-profit social service agency, helps at-risk students use their talents to create positive futures by providing programs that guide them academically, socially and emotionally.

<u>Youth Guidance</u> has served Chicago's youth since 1924. The key to our effectiveness is our ability to deal with the rapid changes of inner-city communities on a neighborhood level. Youth Guidance became a leader in the social service sector in 1969 when we established full-time outposts in the Chicago Public Schools. Working with the children on their turf gives our workers the insight and sensitivity needed to develop innovative programs to help meet the varied needs of students, schools, families and communities.

<u>South Loop Extended Day Program Mission & Vision</u> South Loop Elementary School and Youth Guidance, a non-profit organization, work collaboratively to foster the development of a vibrant community of learners at South Loop School. Our community school programs support student academic achievement and increased parental and community involvement during after school hours. Focused on the needs of South Loop students and students from the community, we continue to seek partnerships to create an enriching and safe place for youth.

## Please read this page carefully!

Dear Families,

South Loop School is not a year-round school, Youth Guidance partners with South Loop School to provide a Summer Camp program for children entering Pre-K through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. This Summer Camp is not a Chicago Public Schools' program and is not subsidized by the Chicago Public Schools. It is a tuition based program. The Summer Camp will operate for 8 weeks, from Monday, June 20 through Friday, August 12, 2011 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily. Camp will be closed on Monday, July 4<sup>th</sup> in observance of the holiday.

Note: A \$15 late fee is charged every 15 minutes for pick-ups after 6 p.m.

Grade levels are reflective of the grade your child will be entering in the Fall of 2011.

#### **General Information:**

Pre-K through K- This camp is for students aged 3 and up who are potty trained! Camp hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please note childcare is NOT available before or after these times, so it is imperative that students are dropped off NO EARLIER than 8:00 am and picked up NO LATER than 6 pm. This camp is held at the South Loop main school building, 1212 South Plymouth Ct. The program cost is \$2,450 (which includes a \$100 registration fee and a \$100 fieldtrip fee to help cover the cost of fieldtrips.) Days will be filled with enriching and engaging age appropriate activities, including arts and crafts, story time, field trips, and outdoor play. A sample schedule can be found later in the packet. Tuition includes breakfast and lunch. Your child may bring an afternoon snack (or their own breakfast and lunch if desired,) and any weatherappropriate items (i.e., water bottle, sunblock).

1st through 4th grades— Camp hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please note childcare is NOT available before or after these times, so it is imperative that students are dropped off NO EARLIER than 8:00 a.m. and picked up NO LATER than 6 p.m. This camp is held at the South Loop main school building, 1212 South Plymouth Ct. The program cost is \$2,300 (which includes a \$100 registration fee and a \$100 fieldtrip fee to help cover the cost of fieldtrips.) Days will be filled with a variety of activities like art, sports, dance, outdoor play, science club, drama, origami and more. Students will also be going swimming once a week and will have weekly fieldtrips to exciting locations in and around Chicago. A sample schedule can be found later in the packet. Tuition includes breakfast and lunch. Your child may bring an afternoon snack (or their own breakfast and lunch if desired,) and any weather appropriate items (i.e. water bottle, sunblock).

5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders will participate in our Leadership Camp, also operating at the main building, 1212 S. Plymouth Ct., Leadership Camp will start at 8:00 am and run until 6:00 pm. Please note childcare is NOT available before or after these times, so it is imperative that students are dropped off NO EARLIER than 8:00 am and picked up NO LATER than 6:00 pm. Students will focus on weekly themes intended to build character and instill community service. They will also participate in sports, field trips and swimming at an off-site location. The cost of the Leadership Camp is \$1,475 (which includes a \$100 registration fee and a \$100 fieldtrip fee to help cover the cost of fieldtrips) This price also includes breakfast and lunch; students are more than welcome to bring their own snack for later in the day.

Camp registration forms are attached. **Registration closes on Friday, May 27.** Tuition is paid in 3 installments (see "Payment Schedule" under Tuition Information). All applications must be completed in full, and accompanied by the first tuition payment as well as a non-refundable \$100 registration fee. Applications without registration fees and tuition will not hold a place in the program. All siblings will receive a discount on their tuition after first student is enrolled.

- \*Financial aid 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> graders: We are now requiring all families interested in receiving financial assistance to apply for aid through the Child Care Action program. If you are interested in applying for aid please email Katie Svaicer Ksvaicer@youth-guidance.org for an application. If you do not qualify for subsidies through the CCA, additional assistance can be made available. All applications for CCA assistance must be completed by June 1, 2011. Registration and fieldtrip fees (\$200 total) must still be paid by financial aid applicants.
- \*Financial aid 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders: Financial aid is available through a grant to provide services to 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders who meet our grantor's income requirements (income guidelines are included). The "Client Intake Form," required by this grant, at the end of the packet, must be completed and returned with the registration materials for all 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> applicants!

# **Camp Descriptions**

For South Loop Summer Camp 2011

#### Pre-K - Kindergarten Camp

Pre-Kindergarten-Kindergarten camp is a full day camp with activities designed for the developmental growth of young children. Activities include arts and crafts, story time, music, games, field trips and outdoor play.

#### Recreational Camp 1st-4th

During the day, campers will be grouped by age and will have the opportunity to sign up for specialties like dance and drama. All students will also rotate among arts and crafts, computer time, science club, movies, game time, and outdoor play/recess. Campers will also participate in field trips to various places of interest such as local museums and theaters. Students will also have the opportunity to swim at an off-site pool each week.

#### Leadership Camp 5th - 8th

Leadership Camp focuses on community service projects, team building activities, sports, etc. to develop leadership skills and build character in older campers. Campers will also participate in weekly field trips to various places of interest, such as local museums and theaters. Students will also have the opportunity to swim at an off-site pool each week.

- Please include your child's name and South Loop Summer Camp in the memo section of the check.
- Payments can also be made online at: <a href="http://interact.youth-guidance.org/afterschool/">http://interact.youth-guidance.org/afterschool/</a>
- No payments will be accepted at the school.
- All payments must be received by the due dates listed in the enclosed schedule.
- Any check returned "non-sufficient funds" shall result in a \$15 charge, and all subsequent payments must be made by money order or certified check.
- > Late payments will result in students being excluded from the program until the previous month's balance is paid in full.
- On exclusion dates, staff at the school do not have the authority to allow the student back into the program. Students cannot be readmitted until the balance is paid in full.
- > Both program administrators AND **Youth Guidance** must be alerted **in writing** (email will suffice) if the student does not plan to return to the program.
- > Failure to give notice will result in responsibility of balance due even if the due date falls after the child left the program\

- ▶ 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade Financial Aid- Please contact Katie Svaicer at KSvaicer@youth-guidance.org for more information on how to apply for the Child Care Action Subsidies. We will need to have both your summer camp registration form and your completed Child Care Action Application on file for your child's registration to be complete. Once you are approved for Child Care Action your monthly payments will only be a fraction of the cost of full tuition. If you do not get approved with Child Care Action, we will work with you to make sure that your child can still be involved in camp and your families' financial situation is supported. All aid applications must be completed in full and be accompanied by the required \$200 (which includes the registration fee of \$100 and the \$100 fieldtrip fee.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- ➤ <u>5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade CDBG Grant-</u> All 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students MUST complete a Client Intake Form and return it with their application. Students who are eligible for the grant will be determined using the information collected on this form. Students who do qualify for CDBG status do not pay any tuition or fees for the camp.
